



## Teen Reach Adventure Camp Volunteer Team

Below is a brief description of different volunteer roles. All volunteers must submit an application, complete a background check and attend an 8-hour training to serve at T.R.A.C.

Camp Counselor: Must be at least 20 years of age.

- Will be matched with two campers, and you will get to invest in them by modeling appropriate behaviors, having affirming conversations and encouraging activity participation throughout the course of camp.

Dean of Men/Women: Must be at least 25 years of age.

- Assist in recruiting and interviewing counselors and work directly with the counselors before and during camp to encourage, support, and pray for them in any way they need.

Placement Coordinator: Must be organized and have good communication skills.

Responsibilities begin in March.

- Will be responsible for camper recruitment. Contacting caseworkers, sending out camper applications, follow up with guardians, and help with camper/counselor pairing.

Behavioral Specialist (Be-Spec): Must be at least 25 years of age. Must have LCSW, LPC, or PsyD

- Will review camper and counselor applications to ensure the most compatible group, inform counselors of any special needs their campers have, and proactively help them create a positive camp experience. Will also assist with training staff and make contact with guardians about any concerns you have about campers.

Medical Station Director: Must be at least 25 years of age. Must have RN, LPN, PA, or MD

- Will be responsible for preparing a medical station and medical supplies for camp, collect medication during registration, keep record of what medications are at camp and when they are dispensed. Discuss any medical concerns with camp director, and advise on the best course of action.

CrossTalk Teacher: Must be at least 25 years of age.

- Will prepare each day's CrossTalk with drama, music, or whatever creative medium available. Will also be responsible for communicating CrossTalk curriculum with counselors to ensure they are confident talking with their campers about it. Works closely with Music Director.

Facility Director: Must be at least 25 years of age.

- Will be responsible for preparing the venue before and during camp. Will organize camper luggage upon arrival and departure, discreetly handle any issues that may arise during camp, and put together a small team to assist with anything you may need.

Registration Director: Must be at least 25 years of age.

- Will be responsible for registration and departure and organize activities to keep campers busy while waiting. You will put together a small team to help with registration and departure.

Activity Center Director: Must be at least 25 years of age.

- Will be responsible for planning 10-20 activities for our campers, gather supplies for camp, and oversee your area at camp.

Facilitators: Level One Must be at least 20 years of age. Level Two Must be at least 25 years of age.

- Will be trained in how to create a safe and engaging environment in which our campers will tell their stories through games and initiatives. Additional training is required for this position.

Prayer Coordinator: Must be at least 25 years of age.

- Will organize, send, and follow up with prayer partners for campers and counselors. Will also be responsible for organizing "Thank You" notes to send to prayer partners after camp.

Music Director: Must be at least 20 years of age.

- Will coordinate songs to engage campers, and work closely with the CrossTalk teacher to make CrossTalk more impactful. You will also be responsible for communicating any equipment needs. This is not a "worship leader".

Photography Director: Must be at least 20 years of age.

- Will be responsible for organizing our "photo processing" area, and creating our camper's albums. Will also create slideshow/video to show at the end of camp.

Grandma and Grandpa or Aunt and Uncle: Must be warm and approachable.

- You will add dimension to camp by making it feel more like a "family". You will be responsible for helping wherever needed, and providing unconditional acceptance to each camper.
